Archuleta County Fair

Budget Work Session Notes – Tuesday, August 16, 2022

The Work session began at 5:30pm at the CSU Extension building. Board members attending: Alexa Martinez, Tonya Steadmon, Sharon Jennings, Kent Jennings, Emily Martinez, Bobby McMeens. Guests attending: Louise Woods/County Finance Director was introduced.

I. 2022 Revenue & Expenses – Copy distributed and attached. An itemized Revenue/Expense report and complete G/L number listing was available on computer. To date, expenses are \$132,778.52 and receipts are \$22,519.84. It was noted that the County allotted \$46,000 to Fair in 2022. Louise said the State Grant funds would not be moved from 2021 to 2022.

Several invoices still to be approved for payment:

Janitor – Heather McCauley \$2,140.00

Operations/Light Towers – Pine Valley Rentals \$ 959.00

Operations/Scissor Lift – Pine Valley Rentals \$ 772.80 (Paid by Fair or a County expense?)

Operations/Spider Boxes & Extension Cords – Pine Valley Rentals \$ 526.00 (Sharon will contact 4-H since this was for Hughes Pavilion)

\$ 970.00 fee was charged to Fair June 30th through County for Disposal Services (Fair disposed of attic items during Clean-up Day; was Fair charged for whole dumpster or shared with CSU?).

\$ 717.85 charge from City Market on the P-Card has no receipt. Sharon will ask Terry Schaaf if same P-Card is used for CSU/4-H spending.

Louise said Fair is a County event. Fair will not be charged for security provided by Sheriff's Dept. No invoice was received for the large dumpsters and rolling trash carts. Was this paid by County?

Several checks are still expected:

Contributions/Donations – Pagosa Springs Medical Center

Contributions/Donations – First Southwest Bank

Concessions Sales: Ice – Vendors, Beer Garden, 4-H, Livestock

Miscellaneous Revenue - Beer Garden (share of receipts)

Sharon will request a copy of the latest County G/L Detail Listing and compare it to the Fair's current Revenue/Expense listing to ensure 2022 expenses are coded to the correct G/L number. \$14,000 fee for the Fair Coordinator will be reclassed from Special Contractual Services #6413 to Other Professional Services #3209.

\$540.00 revenue from The Adventure Zone will be reclassed from Contributions #4040 to Miscellaneous Revenue #5590.

II. 2023 Projected Budget – A copy of the County's Department Detail of Fair's 2021 Budget was distributed as a worksheet for 2023 revenue and expenses. A draft budget for 2023 is attached.
The Board to discuss charging for additional events to increase revenue (a dance, certain activities like Shred BMX demo, fairgrounds admission).
